FrogAsia has launched its free education content for school students in 2017.

Collaborating with YTL Communications Sdn Bhd and Pelangi Publishing Group Bhd (Pelangi), the group will deliver free revision quizzes and tests to some five million students and 500,000 teachers in all 10,000 government schools nationwide through the Frog Virtual Learning Environment (Frog VLE) platform.

Also present were Pelangi Publishing Group Bhd executive chairman and group managing director Datuk Sum Kown Cheek and YTL Communications Sdn Bhd chief executive officer Wing K. Lee.
